About The Driver

Taylor Fletcher is an open wheel racing veteran with more than ten years of racing experience. Like many aspiring Indy Car drivers, karting provided the basic skills that were later sharpened at the world famous Skip Barber Racing School. From 1995 to 2000, he competed in several open wheel divisions including Pro Formula Mazda and Toyota Atlantics. Taylor won the Southern Pacific Regional championship (SPRCS) in the SCCA in 1999 and later achieved second place in the national division point standings in Formula Atlantic as well as several track records on the west coast. In 1998 he achieved second place national honors for the season, competing in the National Auto Sports Association FM class. In 2001, he graduated to the Pan American Indy Car Series, whose races included a combination of ovals and road courses in both Latin America and the United States. He began testing in an IRL IndyCar in 2002 and participated in races in the Indy Racing League Infiniti Pro Series in 2003-2004.

Taylor Fletcher and the entire team also actively promote the children's charity programs and outreach ministries of World Vision, Olive Crest foundation, and IRL Ministries.
